Imvo Zabantsundu (African Opinion) iliphepha-ndaba lokuqala ukuphathwa ngabantu abantsundu eMzantsi Afrika. eLasekwa nguJohn Tengo Jabavu eQonce (King William's Town) ekwiphondo laseMpuma Koloni. Ushicilelo lokuqala lwaba ngoNovember 1884. Imvo Zabantsundu yaba liphepha-ndaba lokuqala ukunika iqonga kubapapashi beendaba abantsundu. Kwaye yaba liphepha-ndaba lokuqala ukubavumela ukuba banike izimvo ngezopolitiko nezasekuhlaleni ngaphandle kokuphathwa nokukhalinyelwa ngamamishini. Eliphepha-ndaba ladlala indima enkulu ekuphuhliseni ezopolitiko zabantu abantsundu ngeloxesha. Lakwenza oku ngokupapasha malunga namaqela ezopolitiko kunye nokukhuthaza ubhaliso lokuvota lwabantu abantsundu, kunye nokulungelelanisa unyulo kwiPalamente yaseKapa. Eliphepha-ndaba lalibhalwa kakhulu ngesiXhosa, ngamanye amaxesha sasibakhona isiNgesi phantsi kwesahloko 'Native Opinion'.

Description

Imvo Zabantsundu (Eng trans: African Opinion) was the first African owned and run newspaper in South Africa. It was founded by John Tengo Jabavu in King William's Town, present day Eastern Cape, with its first edition published in November


